1. 21 O.S. § 1402 • Arson in the second degree: willfully and maliciously sets fire to, or by use of any device or while manufacturing a controlled dangerous substance, destroys any building or structure uninhabited or unoccupied.

**Facts & Circumstance that support probable cause to arrest the above named person are**

On 08/14/2010 at approximately 0405 hours the McCurtain County Sheriff's Department responded to a residential fire located at HC 60 Box 150 Haworth, OK. Deputies made contact with the homeowner, Wendi N. COX, who stated that she was with her daughter at a rodeo in Fouke ARK and returned to her house at around 0300 to find it burning. COX said that her door appeared to be kicked in and that two guns were missing from the residence along with a gold in color Volkswagen Jetta.

State Fire Marshall Lester Blake investigated the scene on the above mentioned date and relayed to Deputies that there were two points of origin, one was the southeast bedroom on the bed and the other was in the living room on the couch. Agent Blake listed the fire as arson.

On 08/26/2010 Clay LUPER was arrested by Broken Bow Police Department while driving the vehicle listed as stolen in this case. During an interview of LUPER he told Deputies that he was living with Cindy DANIELS and her handicapped son. LUPER said that while living there he met Wendi COX who is the nurse who provides for the handicapped son. LUPER said that approximately 2 weeks before the fire COX asked

him to burn her house and said that he could keep the car for payment. LUPER said sometime before the house burned he helped COX move some property to a storage shed in Tom. LUPER said a few weeks prior to the date of the interview he received a call from COX saying that it needed to be done that night. LUPER said he refused and Cindy DANIELS left for a few hours then come back and said it's done. LUPER stated that after the Fire Marshall left COX returned and light the house back on fire and told him that the Fire Marshall left something on.

On 08/22/2011 contact was made with Susan PERALES who stated that she was told several times by COX that she could not pay for the house and it needed to burn. PERALES said that COX asked her many times if she would help burn it. PERALES stated that after the house burned the second time she was told by COX that it was burned by Jaci JACKSON and one of her friends.

On 11/14/2011 contact was made with Kevin CLARK in reference to this case. CLARK stated that sometime in the winter of 2010 he was told by Jaci JACKSON that she had burned her mother, Wendi COX, house by pouring gasoline inside the house. CLARK said that he was told by JACKSON that she was asked to burn the house by Wendi COX so that she could collect the insurance money.

On 11/06/2011 Southeastern State University Police Department interviewed Angel SQUYERS on an unrelated case. During this interview SQUYERS stated that she was told by JACKSON that she burned Wendi COX house down to collect money to pay for a surgery. SQUYERS said that she was told by JACKSON that they removed some property from the house before burning it but left some so it wouldn't look obvious.

On 11/06/2011 Southeastern Arkansas University Police Department interviewed Luke WARE on an unrelated case. During this interview WARE states that he was told by Jaci JACKSON that she had burned two houses down. WARE states that JACKSON said one was burned to collect insurance money.

On 12/05/2011 Mickie CARTER was interviewed at the McCurtain County Sheriff's Department. CARTER stated that a few months before Wendi COX's house burned down that she (COX) brought some of her (COX) property to her (CARTER) residence to store.
