Facts & Circumstance that support probable cause to arrest the above named person are

On 11/03/2011, I was contacted by Cpt. Bruce Shirey and advised that a horse trailer, containing several different types of rodeo equipment, as well as five horses, had been stolen from Southern Arkansas University in Magnolia, Arkansas.

During the investigation, a man named _____ came to the Sheriff Department and stated that he had been having conversations with a woman named Jaci Jackson about the stolen horses from SAU, in Magnolia, Arkansas, the college that Jaci attends. While at the Sheriff's Department, _____ called Jaci and after speaking with her, he stated that Jaci told him that the horses were tied up in an area near her mother, Wendy Cox's residence. _____ stated that Jaci told him that a couple of boys that are on SAU's rodeo team had attempted to rape her and that she planned on stealing the horses to get them kicked off the rodeo team. She said that the two men that were going to assist her in stealing the horses wanted to steal more than just two horses. _____ stated that he asked Jaci where the horses were at and she told him that they were very close to one of her family member's house. He said that she called him later and said that she and three other men had moved the horses from that location and tied them up in some thick brush. _____ said that Jaci stated that they had killed one of the horses and "quartered" it up and scattered it's remains. _____ said that Jaci told him that Wendy Cox then came to their location and picked them up. _____ said that Jaci told him that she wanted him to go look for the horses and described a location as to where the horses were at, located north of her mother's house, on the west side of 8 mile road. On 11/15/2011, four of the five reported horses were found near the area Jaci described.

On 11/17/2011 I met with _____ and recorded a phone conversation between him and Jaci Jackson. During that conversation, Jaci stated that Billy Hamilton, her mother's boyfriend had killed the horse known as Credit Card by shooting it and cutting it's throat. Jaci said that they then "quartered" it up and scattered it's remains. On 11/25/2011, the remains of Credit Card were found in a pasture area, approximately one-half mile north of Wendy's house. The remains were identified by the owner of Credit Card. The remains were found in five different locations. Dr. Kyle Pratt D.V.M. looked at the cut markings on the horse and stated that they appeared to have been used by some type of cutting instrument.
